Special Information

1. Please use the main entrance of the school. It is not necessary to sign in with the receptionist. Proceed past Guidance and the Attendance Office. Go downstairs; continue straight through the doors by the elevator. There will be a book at the Room 023 entrance for you to sign your child in and out. You may exit from the outside doors near Room 023.
2. Children should not be left in the classroom until the teacher arrives. Make sure Mrs. Bowne sees you when you arrive. Please be prompt in picking up your child since the teacher and students have to go to their next classes. Please send a note if someone other than the scheduled person is picking up your child.
3. Parking will be creative. Visitor spaces are immediately along the fence as you enter from Memorial Avenue. You may want to try and carpool.
4. All children must be toilet trained and able to handle toilet hygiene independently. One set of extra clothes, clearly labeled on the outside of a bag should be sent to school on the first day. It will be kept at the bottom of their cubbies in case of accidents.
5. Children should wear comfortable, washable clothes. Remember to choose clothes so your child can easily use the bathroom. Please label all coats, hats, etc.
6. Children should not attend school with serious colds or other communicable diseases.

7. Toys from home should not be brought to school except for special programs like "Show and Tell." Notices for such events will be sent home with the children.
8. I am requesting that each parent be responsible for a snack for at least two (2) days during nursery school. We will supply juice and napkins. Some suggestions are: crackers, pretzels, fruit, or vegetables in easy to serve pieces. Please sign up during the first week of class. Please do not send in any peanut products. I will let you know about any other allergies to be aware of. I am also asking that each child bring in a box of wipes or hand sanitizer and tissues.
9. Nursery school will be cancelled in the event of a 2-hour delay. Late starts or school cancellations are posted on the district website.

11. Please make sure that your child's immunizations are up to date and that I have a copy of them for the school nurse.

**Immunizations Required for Pre-K Registration
(NJ Sanitary Code Chapter 14: NJAC Title 8:57 - 4.1 et seq.)**

1. DPT/DTaP - 4 doses (one on or after 4th birthday)
2. Polio - 3 doses (one on or after 4th birthday)
3. HIB - 1 dose
4. MMR - 1 dose
5. HEP B - 3 doses
6. Varicella - 1 dose
7. Pneumococcal - 1 dose
8. Influenza - 1 dose
